Solid / Liquid Waste Management Policy

Preamble

Waste Management is intended to reduce adverse effects of wastes generated in the campus. The aim is to reduce the ill effects of wastes in the campus environment and stakeholders health.

Objectives:

- ➤ Reduce the volume of the solid wastes generation in the campus.
- Ensuring environmental sustainability in the campus.
- > Protecting groundwater sources.
- > Reducing air pollution in the campus.
- Recovery of energy from solid wastes.

Action Plan:

Segregation of solid waste into Biodegradable and Non-Biodegradable at the place of origin itself.

Composting of canteen / hostel wastes into vermicompost. The generated compost is used in the campus as organic manure to plants.

Non-biodegradable wastes are disposed through the vendors appointed by the college management.

Hazardous chemicals used in the chemistry laboratories are disposed as per the Hazardous and other wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 notified by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India.
