

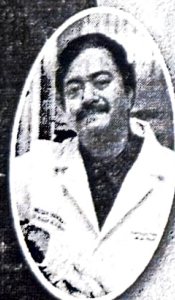

He explained the dominance of Plant as object for several scientific research, with the Artistic and Intellectual Interests. It had been a central objects of research in the 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> centuries. Plant research has enrich our intellectual life and Increase our scientific knowledge. Results of the research teach us how to approach and handle Agriculture, Health and Environment. From the origin of human civilization, we depends on plant for their development, Prosperity and ability to manage Plants. He elaborated the importance of Plant as food, fuel, fodder and medicine. Modern civilization rest on successful and sustained cultivation of Plants and wise use of their biological and Physical sources. Plants are unique and interesting and has the totipotency effect which could regenerate from seeds, barks, Pieces. Plants are the new sources of Oxygen, Carbohydrates and Amino acids by the Process called Photosynthesis. Plants Compact the global warming. He gave the importance of future Plant research in bioplastic, biofuel, flavourings, construction materials, biopesticides, biofertilizers, Cosmetic, clothing and genome editing.

Session starts with the online Webinar by S.K. Bhatnagar, Founder & Secretary (SPR), Former, Professor & Dean, College of Biotechnology, S.V.P. University of




Agric & Technology, Meerut. He gave a lecture on various topics of current research on Plant Science. Particularly, He suggested the young Scientists to explore more plant species as there 90 to 95% are still unexplored. He elaborated the various Genetic engineering, enzyme technological applications and their requirements for the current scenario.


Second session was delivered by Dr. T. Arumugam, Dean, Horticultural College and Research Institute, Periyakulam on "Plant Genetic Resources (PGR) and Crop Improvement (CI)". He starts the lecture with the explanation for resources and its ecological importance. Plant as the major source for human and animals for their food and clothing. In India, about 12% of world's plant species are in habitat, which make India as mega Biodiversity hot spot. Particularly, in Western Ghats the species richness and climatic conditions make it as a biodiversity niche. These informations are documented through Geo-satellite images. He explained about various centres for maintain genetic resources like NBPGR in Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala, NBAGR, Haryana, NBFGR, Lucknow, NBIGR, Bangalore. From the year 1976 these conservation centres starts their function. He also pointed out

traditional method of storing seeds in the kalasas of Temple for restoration of genetic materials for the next 12 years. He also highlighted about the eleven nodal centres of **NBPGR** and their conservation methods. He advised our students how to collect, utilize and conserve G.T.N. College Campus plant species. At the end of the session, he answered questions like how to conserve the genetic resource in mutation breeding and conservation how horticulture department support food processing industries, how this **Covid 19** Pandemic situation affects agricultural activities.


Dr. R. Ramya, Principal and Head, Dept. of Biotechnology, Surana College, Peenya, Bangalore, delivered a talk on "**Metagenomic Analysis and its Applications**". Her speech reflects her expertise in the Metagenomics
