MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MoU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1

COOPERATION

Department of Business Administration, G.T.N Arts College (Autonomous), Dindigul-5 and National Institute of Information Technology, Dindigul recognize their strengths and their mutual interest in engaging themselves in academic cooperation.

CLAUSE 2

OBJECTIVES / SCOPE

The MoU is signed between **Department of Business Administration**, G.T.N Arts College (Autonomous), Dindigul-5 and National Institute of Information Technology, Dindigul to promote the employability skills of the students by providing training students to meet the industrial needs. The purpose of this MoU are,

- To provide training & certification on business related applications as MS Office,
 Advanced Excel, Tally, Social Media related applications etc... to BBA Students.
- Also to provide basic programming language skills like Python which helps the students to get employability in banking sector.
- To bridge an Industry Institutional interaction.
- To organize the workshops, seminars and provide Value added business related software training to BBA students.
- To impart the Basic and Advanced application software skills and guide the students to develop projects and implements simple applications.

Department of Business Administration, G.T.N Arts College (Autonomous), Dindigul-5 and National Institute of Information Technology, Dindigul further agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be separately determined and agreed upon by the two institutions. These terms shall include a technical description of the proposed activity, arrangements, and person(s) responsible for its implementation, etc.

A. Joint Sponsored Research, Development and Consulting

Department of Business Administration, G.T.N Arts College (Autonomous), Dindigul-5 and National Institute Of Information Technology, Dindigul agree to help identify and invite members of Department of Business Administration from the other institution to participate in research or development programmes. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between the Department of Business Administration, G.T.N Arts College (Autonomous), Dindigul-5 and National Institute of Information Technology, Dindigul.

B. Exchange of Team members

Department of Business Administration, G.T.N Arts College (Autonomous), Dindigul-5 and National Institute of Information Technology, Dindigul agree to encourage collaboration between team members of Department of Business Administration from the two institutions to encourage members of their team to undertake short visits to, or take up fixed-term visiting assignments at, each other's institution as per the existing norms for the purpose of education/research. Terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment, including those concerning name of the concerned member will be worked out between Department of Business Administration, G.T.N Arts College (Autonomous), Dindigul-5 and National Institute Of Information Technology, Dindigul.

C. Student Exchange

Department of Business Administration, G.T.N Arts College (Autonomous), Dindigul-5 and National Institute of Information Technology, Dindigul agree that Department of Business Administration student exchange will be only for the sole purpose of educational / research purposes like internships, projects, assignments, conferences and workshops and will be guided by principles listed below.

A home institution refers to the institution where a student is a full-time student or part time attached to the same, and from where he / she is expected to gain some knowledge certificates or degrees. A host institution refers to an institution that receives a student for a brief period of time to undertake a predetermined programme study or research / education programme.

- 1. Exchange students will be selected by mutual agreement between the home institution and the host institution.
- 2. His / her program of study at the host institution will be determined by mutual consultation between his / her academic adviser at the home institution and his/her "interim" academic advisor identified by the host institution.

- The host institution will evaluate an exchange student's performance in each course or module; award a letter of appreciation completion.
- 4. If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the host institution will evaluate the exchange student's performance in the research, and issue a letter to that effect, together with a technical 'report' of the research carried out.
- The exchange students will be liable to pay any type of fees for if any, for that particular program.

D. Exchange of Scientific and Technical Material

Department of Business Administration, G.T.N Arts College (Autonomous), Dindigul-5 and National Institute of Information Technology, Dindigul will exchange information on research and educational programmes and teaching bearing material related to Business Administration and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes. Further, Department of Business Administration, G.T.N Arts College (Autonomous), Dindigul-5 and National Institute of Information Technology, Dindigul agree to explore ways to share teaching bearing material, and other relevant literature, while respecting each other's intellectual property and other rights.

E. Joint Conferences, workshops, FDPs, Guest lectures, and short-term courses

members from various areas of Business Administration from other institutions to participate in

conferences, workshops and short-term courses.

F. Coordination

Each institution shall appoint one member of its team to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination comminee, consisting of

CLAUSE 3

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Department of Business Administration, G.T.N Arts College (Autonomous), Dindigul-5 and National Institute of Information Technology, Dindigul agree to respect each other's rights to intellectual property.

Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppels or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

Further, the intellectual property rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research or activity under this MoU will be worked out on a case-by-case basis, and will be consistent with the officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutions.

CLAUSE 4

TENURE, TERMINATION AND VALIDITY

This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for an Academic Year from 2020- 2021 to 2021- 2022, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution six months in advance. Once terminated, neither Department of Business Administration, G.T.N Arts College (Autonomous), Dindigul-5 nor National Institute of Information Technology, Dindigul will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, Department of Business Administration, G.T.N Arts College (Autonomous), Dindigul-5 and National Institute of Information Technology, Dindigul will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.

CLAUSE 5

ARBITRATION

Should there be a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, Head of the Department of Business Administration / Principal / Director / Founder / CEO G.T.N Arts College (Autonomous), Dindigul-5 and National Institute of Information Technology, Dindigul will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility.
