With this quote, I am delighted to present the 60th Annual Report with a summary of our achievements on the academic, co-curricular and the extra-curricular front for the year 2023-2024. Seminars, workshops and invited lectures are the routine features of the G.T.N. intellectual environment.

College Strength

The College has the optimum students' admission in all programmes of both aided and self-supporting streams with 4933 in total. The intake of the students has increased by 67 compared to last year. The faculty strength is enlarged to 237 with the inclusion of new appointments in aided and in self-supporting streams. Dr. A. Bilal Ahamed joined as Assistant Professor in the Aided department of English in the month of October 2023 and there is an inclusion of 64 faculties in Self Supporting Programme. Understanding the scope, the new academic programme B.Sc. Artificial Intelligence was introduced in the academic year 2023-2024.

Admission

The admission of students was carried out by a duly constituted admission committee. The selection was purely on merit basis and in accordance with the guidelines of Government of Tamil Nadu and Madurai Kamaraj University. 50% of the Management Quota was allotted to

the students who narrowly missed their chance to make it in the merit list and to the deserving students.

IQAC

The IQAC team of the college has been functioning since 2014 with a mission in enhancing and sustaining excellence in the academic and administrative practices and to set benchmarks for the periodic evaluation. The IQAC of the college has submitted Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) for the academic year 2023-2024 on 22/02/2024.

Research and Development

The Research & Development Cell of our college is functioning effectively with the new guidelines of the Ministry of Education. In order to promote research activities among staff and students, the Management has initiated in-house funding, namely Seed money, Student Start up projects, research incentives/ honorarium, travel grant support etc. To promote inter-disciplinary and quality research, the research advisory/steering committee guides the staff in identifying suitable funding agencies to submit their research proposals.

It also conducted various on-campus placement drives for final year students with 1120 reputed companies and nearly 600 students received offer letters. A Resume writing program was conducted for the final year students by Veranda Race.

Due to time constraints, I am unable to highlight the further accomplishments of both faculties and students. However, these achievements are thoroughly documented in the comprehensive college report.
